

The American Forest & Paper Association (AF&PA) has released a new report indicating

that the vast majority of Americans, 94 percent, have access to community paper and

paperboard recycling programs. The 2021 AF&PA Access to Recycling Study is a comprehensive national report that tracks and measures the growth of consumer access to community paper and paperboard recycling in the U.S. It is the latest in a series commissioned by AF&PA and conducted since 1994. Items such as corrugated cardboard, mail, newspapers, office paper, magazines, paperboard boxes with and without poly coatings, paper bags, liquid packaging cartons and pizza boxes have a consumer access rate of 60 percent or more. In



2021, the U.S. paper industry reached a record level for containerboard production and saw a 6.8 percent increase, compared to 2020, in the consumption of old-corrugated containers (OCC) at mills to make new products. **Fund to Help Advance New Modular** Recycling




